#### **Onesole Women's Shoes**

Imagine owning a comfortable pair of open back slip on shoes that you can change to fit any color or style outfit that you are wearing! I FOUND JUST THAT!!! While they are certainly not a replacement for sneakers in any way, they are comfortable and really provide a wonderful alternative to buying several different pair or summer sandals, slip on dress shoes or clogs. They are wonderful to travel with as well *if* you can wear and walk in open backed shoes.

The way that they work is so simple, yet so creative. You buy a base "sole" style and color. They range in heel shape and height from 1" flats, 2" wedges, 3, 4 or 5" heels and more, in various styles. The bases come in white, tan, cork or black colors.

Again, you choose a base in your shoe size, picking the appropriate shape and height of the heel, then from there, you pick the "tops" you want. Each base "sole" purchase entitles you to 3 free "tops" which then simply "snap" on to the base! One of the three tops come standard in solid black and then you may pick 2 additional colors, styles or patterns!

I am bringing ONE black wedge style walking "base sole" with me on vacation and then also taking about 10 "snap on tops" in various colors and patterns to match my outfits and dresses. It will take up barely any room in my luggage but provide me with essentially 10 different pair of shoes!

They are very soft and comfortable bases and the snap on tops are made of stretch neoprene which nicely mold around any foot shape, regular wide or narrow. There are no options for men's footwear yet but they do have styles available for younger girls and college ages. ## Baked Eggs and Ham Recipe **Ingredients**

1/4 cup seasoned croutons 2 tablespoons chopped fully cooked ham 1 tablespoon butter, melted 2 eggs

1 tablespoon shredded cheddar cheese Fresh fruit, optional

#### **Directions**

In a greased shallow 2-cup baking dish, toss the croutons, ham and butter. Break the eggs carefully on top.

Sprinkle with cheese.

Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 15-18 minutes or until eggs reach desired doneness. Serve with fresh fruit on the side if desired. **Yield:** 1 serving.

## Pink Lemonade Slushy Ingredients

1 cup freshly squeezed lemon juice (5 to 6 lemons) 1/2 to 3/4 cup superfine sugar, to taste 1 cup crushed ice 4 cups water 2 teaspoons grenadine 6 maraschino cherries

#### **Directions**

Place the lemon juice, sugar, ice, water, and grenadine in a blender and process until completely smooth. Place a cherry in the bottom of 6 glasses and pour the lemon juice mixture in the glass. Serve
